Candidate: That's all for today. Thank you very much.

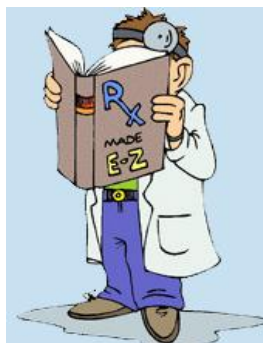

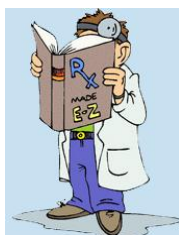


